The T11 committee has prepared a project proposal for a project entitled SAN Management - Attribute & Method Dictionary (SM-AMD). The project is intended to develop a Technical Report to cross-reference the attributes and methods defined by a number of existing industry standards and other definitions with respect to storage network management,

The motion to accept the project proposal contained in T11/02-692v3 (SM-AMD) and forward it to INCITS for further processing was accepted by a meeting vote in the December 12, 2002 meeting of T11, held in Tucson, AZ. The motion "that the Management Model (SM-MM) Project Proposal (02-691v2, v1 as modified @ T11.5, v0 as modified @ the SG) be approved as a proposal for a new project, and that the project be assigned to T11.5" carried with 39 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 Abstaining, and with 21 Not Voting. The membership stood at 60 in this meeting. The vote met the two-thirds rule. The vote is recorded in clause 12.1.3 of the enclosed minutes, T11/02-762v1. Note that T11/02-692v2 has been stored on the web-site under the name T11/02-692v3 because of an administrative restriction on the web-site.

Could you please take the appropriate steps to carry forward the recommendation of T11 and accept the project as a type DT project to be developed within T11.
