Dear Deborah,

The T11 committee has prepared a project proposal for a technical report entitled:

Fibre Channel Signal Modeling - 2 (FCSM-2).

The technical report is intended to be a collection of recommendations on methodologies to be used to simulate FC signals. These methodologies support the current family of Fibre Channel standards and are designed to work at the data rates expected to be specified through 2008. FCSM-2 extends the material contained in FCSM.

The motion to accept the project proposal contained in T11/03-142v1 (FCSM-2) and forward it to INCITS for further processing was accepted by a meeting vote in the April 10, 2003 meeting of T11, held in Santa Fe, NM.

The motion "that the project proposal for FCSM-2 contained in 03-142v1 be accepted and forwarded to INCITS for further processing" carried with a vote of 38 for, 0 opposed, with 1 abstaining and 18 not voting. This meets the two-thirds rule.

The vote will be recorded in clause 10.2.2 of the draft minutes, expected to be posted within 8 days on the www.t11.org web-site. An extract from the draft in preparation of the minutes is enclosed with this letter.

Could you please take the appropriate steps to carry forward the recommendation of T11 and accept the project as a type DT project to be developed within T11.2.
